To whom it may concern,

Due to the information published today in "The report 'Whose representatives? MEPs on the industry payroll", I would like to present the explanation to the information concerning myself that appears in the report.

I would like to inform that since 1st July 2014 I have had no other commitments than my activity as a Member of the European Parliament.

I apologize for my incorrectly filled Declaration of the Member's Financial Interests, which I submitted on July 1st, 2014.

I had incorrectly interpreted points D and E of this Declaration and I read that in these two points I have to submit information about membership and remuneration in any boards or committees of any companies, non-governmental organisations, associations for the last 3 years as it is required in point A of the same Declaration. That is why, I have filled in both of this points.

I would like to inform you that I have resigned or ended any membership in boards and committees of companies, non-governmental organisations or associations that could bring me any remuneration or any financial benefit.

I would like to inform you that these external activities took place only between January 2014 and June 2014 when I did not serve in any public functions. Before that, between 2009 and 2013 I was a member of the Polish government and therefore did not have any external commitments than as a member of the government.

My contract with Polish Confederation Lewiatan was ended in June 2014 before I have taken up the office as a Member of the European Parliament.

I would like to apologise for this mistake in the Declaration of the Member's Financial Interests which was due to the misinterpretation and the will to inform about all my previous engagement and was not in any part intended to provide false information or create confusion.
