Request for Access to Documents/Information relating to the Trans-Atlantic Trade Investment Partnership (TTIP)

We are writing to you to request information and documentation concerning the TTIP negotiations. We make this request under Regulation 1049/2001, which is to be interpreted in accordance with Regulation EC No 1367/2006, given that our request relates to environmental information.

- a) The text of the EU's negotiation mandate;

- c) Any other reports or papers provided to the US by the EU on the topics identified in b) above;
- d) Any reports or papers provided to EU Member States and the European Parliament on the topics identified in b) above.
