Quick and Easy

Flashmob against the decision making behind closed doors

- 10 people and more
- in the shopping mall/the market, ...
- blindfold



Even if TTIP will have major impacts on our democracy and social and environmental standards, it is mainly discussed in secret talks.

A flashmob can raise awareness about this. On a sign, one part of your group takes on the blindfolds (you bind also your mouth) and walks blindly with stretched out hands. Some should take care that the blind people don't get hurt accidentally. A third group collects signatures and responds to questions from the public.

Farmers' market

Grab a friend or two and collect signatures at your local farmers' market. Optionally: Having seeds, some cake, cookies as a small present for all the passers-by that support you.

Takes some planning

Nettle pesto party

- +/- 10 people
- in nature; in the kitchen

Discover local food alternatives by inviting friends, colleagues, fellow pupils or students to a hike where you collect nettle. End up in your kitchen and make nettles pesto.

Seed exchange

It's the season for planting – so why not ask the participants of your next YFoE event to bring along seeds. During the event, participants can not only share these seeds, but also they can exchange about how best to grow and care for the



plants. Of course you should seize the opportunity to inform about TTIP and collect signatures within your YFoE group.

Challenging

No genetically modified popcorn, stop TTIP

- 3 people
- 1 cinema
- up to 50 bags of popcorn
- signature list

TTIP undermines our food standards. In the future, industrial food corporations may impose genetically modified corn due to TTIP.

GMO-popcorn? No thanks. Try to get a cinema on your side. Either try to deliver anti-TTIP popcorn bags in front of the cinema or make an arrangement with the cinema to make them use your bags but their popcorn. Be present at the beginning and the end of the film to collect signatures for the Stop TTIP petition.
